<p>Commission Selection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9 members of Little Hoover Commission • 5 chosen by Governor; 2 chosen by Speaker; 2 chosen by Senate Rules Committee. • All appointing bodies might be from same party; no more than 4 commissioners can be from the same party. • Requires commission to be diverse in ethnic, geographic, and gender representation. 	<p>Commission Selection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11 member Commission • Creates a “jury-style” selection process. 1000 voters are randomly put into a pool from each county. • Secretary of State draws name from pool, decides whether to keep name or return it to pool for diversity reasons. • Requires commission to be diverse in ethnic, geographic, urban/rural and gender representation. 	<p>Commission Selection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11 member Commission • A pool is created by a judge panel. The legislative leaders can each strike objectionable names from the pool. The 11 members are randomly drawn from the remaining pool. • The bodies involved in the selection are from different parties. The commission will have 4 Dems, 4 Reps, and 3 unaffiliated members. • Requires commission to be diverse in ethnic, geographic, and gender representation. 	<p>Commission Selection</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 11 member Commission • A pool is created by a judge panel. The legislative leaders can each strike objectionable names from the pool. 8 (Ds/Rs) of the members are chosen by the legislative leaders, 3 (Us) are randomly drawn. • The bodies involved in the selection are from different parties. The commission will have 4 Dems, 4 Reps, and 3 unaffiliated members. • Requires commission to be diverse in ethnic, geographic, and gender representation.
