SUPPORT AB 1436 (Feuer) Same Day Registration

The reality is that campaign communications peak in the last two weeks before Election Day—after California’s voter registration deadline.

Same Day Registration would allow an eligible person to register to vote and immediately vote on Election Day or anytime in the month leading up to Election Day at county election offices. The number of locations may be expanded over time.

Same Day Registration will be more cost effective now that California is implementing online voter registration.

Same Day Registration in California is an important reform that pushes back on national efforts to pass voter suppression laws.

Background:

- ✓ **Same Day Registration** is used by 9 states. States with SDR have historically had turnout rates 10 to 12% higher than non-SDR states.**
- ✓ **Same Day Registration** broadens the diversity of the electorate** while providing for a new level of secure validation of voters.
