



SB 1107 (Allen) Accountable Elections

In 2015, cities and counties from Seattle, WA, to Montgomery County, MD, created programs to incentivize candidates to connect with constituents, instead of chasing big donations from special interests. SB 1107 would amend the Political Reform Act to allow California to adopt innovative programs.

SB 1107's key features:

- Lets California and local governments to adopt innovative approaches to address the outsized influence of special interests.
- Strengthens penalties for elected officials convicted of selling access to their office.
- Bans foreign corporations and governments from contributing to state and local candidates.
- This measure would be referred to voters for final approval.
