Legislation Would Allow Late Hawaii Voter Registration

House Bill 2590, introduced by Rep. **Kaniela Ing**, would allow **late voter registration** at absentee polling places beginning in 2016 and late voter registration on **election day** at both absentee polling and precinct polling places beginning in 2018.

The **Office of Elections**, **Common Cause Hawaii** and the **League of Women Voters of Hawaii** support HB 2590 as a way to increase voter participation. But county clerks on **Oahu**, **Hawaii** and **Kauai** expressed concerns about the legislation's impact on operations.
