UH Regents John C. Dean and Saedene Ota submitted resignation letters to Gov. Neil Abercrombie earlier this month, citing concerns about a financial disclosure bill.

The resignations leave Ota's Maui County seat, as well as her vice chair position, open. Dean's departure, meanwhile, leaves an open Honolulu County seat on the Board, the Associated Press reports.

The bill, SB 2682, would require that members of state commissions and boards make public financial disclosures. Abercrombie had placed the bill on the list of proposals approved by the legislature that he intends to veto, but he has yet to formally reject the measure.

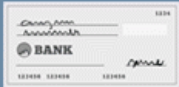
