House Bill HJRCA 58

General Comments:

I agree with Common Cause in its support for HJRCA 58. An independent map commission with public testimony in open meetings, will provide real independence by prohibiting involvement from the Legislature and the Governor in selection of commission members. HJRCA 58 also provides accountability because the commissioners will be chosen by those accountable to the voters. HJRCA 58 also stipulates that districts must be compact and gives priority to the creation of majority-minority districts
