

DEMOCRACY AMENDMENT

Dear Massachusetts U.S. Representatives,

A constitutional amendment is necessary to protect and preserve our democracy. An avalanche of special interest money is buying our elections and policy. Just as important, the extension of constitutional rights to corporations has resulted in the courts overturning hundreds of laws protecting our health, safety, environment, and democracy. To address these threats to self-government, **we urge you to sponsor a constitutional amendment in the House affirming that 1) corporations are not entitled to the constitutional rights of human beings, and that 2) money spent to influence elections may be regulated by Congress and the states, and such regulation is not prohibited by the First Amendment.**
