## What College & University Students need to know

To vote on November 4th, you **MUST** present an acceptable **Voter ID** at the polls.



- Or you can use your:**
- MS Driver's License or State ID Card
  - Unexpired US Passport
  - Military ID Card
  - An employee identification card
  - Tribal photo ID Card
  - A firearms license
  - Any other state or US government ID

**You can use your Student ID Card

If you arrive at the polling place on Nov. 4 without an acceptable ID, you can vote by affidavit. **However**, your vote will not count **unless** you present an acceptable ID at the Circuit Clerk's Office in your county by Nov. 8
