This year, Colorado Common Cause was hard at work at the Capitol supporting legislation that will strengthen and protect our state's democracy and fighting against anti-voter bills that would tarnish our gold-standard election system.

## In 2022 we



gathered **2,880 SIGNATURES** on 4 petitions

sent **2,245 LETTERS** to lawmakers



testified **21 TIMES** at the state legislature

attended **5 BILL-SIGNING CEREMONIES** with the governor





# The bills we supported will

## Make voting safer for everyone

HB22-1086 bans the open carry of firearms within 100 feet of polling centers, drop boxes, and vote count facilities.

## Protect election workers

HB22-1273 adds new protections for election workers against threats, harassment, intimidation, and doxing.

## Enhance safeguards in our election system

SB22-153 adds new and increases some security requirements so that our elections are protected from all threats, including internal ones.

## Rein in money in politics

HB22-1060 creates campaign finance limits for school board candidates.



# The bills we defeated would have

## Abolished our popular, convenient, and secure universal vote-by-mail system

HB22-1204 would have required all voters to cast a ballot at their precinct on Election Day and that all votes be counted within 24 hours.

## Caused the incorrect cancellation of countless voter registrations

HB22-1084 attempted to add unnecessary and inaccurate processes to our already robust voter list maintenance procedures.

## Called for a dangerous Article V Convention

HJR22-1021 was an attempt to add Colorado to a growing list of states calling for an Article V Constitutional Convention which would put all our rights in jeopardy.
