

On Election Day, November 8, 2022 in Connecticut, there is a question (Question 1) on the ballot that reads: "Shall the Constitution of the State be amended to permit the General Assembly to provide for early voting?"

With early voting, Connecticut voters would have the option to vote in-person at designated locations on specified days in advance of Election Day.	Connecticut is one of only four states with no in-person early voting
On Tuesday, Nov. 8, Vote YES on Question 1	Many voters work 2 or 3 jobs just to keep their families afloat and need more options than just a single day to get time off for voting
