

Register to Vote Online



RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov



Have the following information ready:

- Your Florida Driver License or Florida ID Card number and date of issuance
- Last 4 digits of your Social Security Number
- Your residential address (no P.O. boxes)
- Your mailing address (if different from your residence address)

*If you don't have a Florida Driver License or Florida ID Card,
you'll need to submit a signed paper registration form.*

You can pre-fill the form at RegisterToVoteFlorida.gov and then print it out.

You must register at least 29 days before Election Day!

- If you miss the deadline, you won't be able to vote until the following election.

You can register if you can say YES to all of these:

- I am a U.S. Citizen
- I am at least 18 years old (16 and 17 year-olds can pre-register)
- I am a Florida resident
- I have not been adjudicated mentally incapacitated with respect to voting or my right to vote has been restored
- I have not been convicted of a felony or my right to vote has been restored
